League Rules (Revised Oct 2013)

- 1. The league will be known as the Carshalton & District Darts League
- 2. All funds will be kept in the name of Carshalton & District Darts League
- 3. The league season will commence in October of each year and should be completed by May
- 4. A membership fee of £55-00 will be paid before the start of the season , the fee is non refundable should any team drop out of the league
- 5.The league games shall consist of 16 games, 4 x drawn pairs (701), 8 x drawn singles (501) 4 x drawn pairs (701), The <u>away</u> team will throw first in the odd numbered legs, the draw to be made by both captains by means of playing cards or any fair method that is mutually agreeable.
- 6. Each team may have up to 2 reserves, once the reserves have been used **the original players** <u>cannot</u> be re-used. Substitutions must be made before the draw takes place.
- 7. League competitions will take place at the end of the season, and consist of fours, pairs, singles and an 8's
- 8. Cancellations; any team giving less than 24 hours notice of postponement of game or failing to turn up will forfeit the match, +10 points will be awarded to their opponents and -4 points will be deducted from the defaulting team, the league secretary must also be informed by the team cancelling, or by the team if their opponents fail to turn up.
- 9. All players must be registered before the season starts, new players must be registered at least 7 days prior to playing, any team found playing unregistered players will forfeit the game and points will be awarded the same as a cancellation (rule 8)
- 10. No cancellation will be accepted from any team who have 10 or more players signed on, the only exception to this rule are if there is a function on at the venue of the home team and the fixture cannot be reversed. Any other exceptional circumstances must be brought to the attention of the league secretary and his decision will be final
- 11. <u>THE HOME TEAM</u> is responsible for seeing the result card reaches the league secretary no later than noon of the Saturday following the match, the result should be e-mailed wherever possible.
- 12. Match cards to be filled in by both teams before the start of the game, full names (not nicknames) must be used, tons, game shots, 180's and high out shots must all be recorded and checked by both captains at games end
- 13. The winner of the league will be the team with the most points, in the event of two teams having equal points at the end of the season then the team with the highest away points will be the deciding factor, a play off match will be played if the away points are also equal
- 14. Players can transfer between teams only with the league secretaries permission and no transfers will be allowed after February
- 15. A match can only commence with a minimum of 5 players, if a team turns up with a minimum of 5 players they cannot cancel that match
- 16. If matches are cancelled and a double banker or catch up match cannot be played, then the league secretary will decide the fairest way to award the points.
